It really helped my family when I couldn't work," shared one parent. Another said, "As a single mother, this helped me get diapers,

fruits and vegetables when I had no income coming in." In addition to financial support, families were connected to vital community resources such as food banks, settlement services, clothing programs and mental health supports. Front-line staff played a key role, working closely with families to identify needs and ensure they weren't navigating these challenges alone. Thanks to your support, we're able to be there for families when it matters most—offering relief, connection and a path to greater stability.




